TEN COMMANDMENTS

Exodus 20:1-17

Mt Sinai



AT MOUNT SINAI

1. Three months after Israel was delivered out of slavery in Egypt (19:1)
2. Remain at Sinai for 11 months (Num 10:28)
3. Exodus 19 to Numbers 11 => 58 chapters



TEN COMMANDMENTS

1. GOD SPOKE TO THE NATION OF ISRAEL (Exod 20:1)
2. RIGHT VIEW OF GOD (Exod 20:1-7)
3. RIGHT VIEW OF MAN (Exod 20:12-17)
4. CALL TO LOVE GOD AND TO LOVE NEIGHBOR
5. THE HEART OF MOSAIC COVENANT
6. STANDARDS OF GOD'S RIGHTEOUSNESS
7. TO BE OBEYED BY ISRAEL (DEUT 5:32-33)

1. The LORD – the Redeemer / Israel – the beneficiary
2. Personal God - You – singular (the nation as One)
3. The Priority – ONLY ONE GOD (Deut 4:35, 6:4; Is 43:10, 44:6-8, 45:5-6, 45:21-22)

THE ONLY ONE GOD

"I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.
"You shall have no other gods before Me." (Exod 20:2-3)

THE ONLY TRUE GOD

“You shall not make for yourself an idol, or any likeness of what is in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the water under the earth. ‘You shall not worship them or serve them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, on the third and the fourth generations of those who hate Me, but showing lovingkindness to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments.” (Exod 20:4-6)

THE ONLY TRUE GOD

1. God manifested Himself – NO visible way
2. Right view of God leads to Proper worship of God
3. YHWH will not share His glory with another
 - a) I am a jealous God –
 - b) Judgement to the 3rd and 4th generation
4. The Divine Love and Loyalty
 1. 4/1000

THE ONLY TRUE GOD

1. God demands proper worship today (Acts 17:29)
2. Problem of our world – the problem of worship (Rom 1:18-23)
3. The Father is seeking true worshipers (John 4:21-24)
4. Examine your heart of worship
 1. Dedicate Sacrifice Devote
 2. Excitement Sing Study
 3. Time Money Witness

THE NAME ABOVE ALL NAMES

“You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain, for the Lord will not leave him unpunished who takes His name in vain.” (Exod 20:7)

1. The Name – The LORD (YHWH)
 - a. YHWH – 6,828 in OT, 1,820 in Pentateuch, 398 in Exodus
2. The Name – I AM WHO I AM (Exod 3:13-15)
 - a. God IS – no beginning and no end, never changing, ever present
 - b. God is eternal, self-existent, present at every event in time

THE NAME ABOVE ALL NAMES

“You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain, for the Lord will not leave him unpunished who takes His name in vain.” (Exod 20:7)

2. Take – carry, lift up, to speak
3. Vain – empty, scandalous way
 - a) Jer 14:14-16
4. Hallowed Be Your Name - Matt 6:7-9
